## GETTING TO KNOW YOU

"Welcome to your new home." Someone from Riverside recently said this to me during one of my first days at the church. It was a very

encouraging thing to say and it made me feel welcome. Now by the time you read this, we will have already spent a couple of Sundays together in worship. Hopefully I will have had the opportunity to meet you or, if not, will get the chance to do so in the near future. To be fair, I have a lot of names to try to learn and remember whereas you only have one. Furthermore, remembering to call me Pastor David really isn't going to be too difficult for you, now is it?

As we get better acquainted, one of the things that I think will help facilitate our transition to Riverside is to hold cottage meetings over the next few months. A cottage meeting is simply a listening post in which I can meet with a group of 8-12 people, usually in someone's home, and spend some time in dialogue with folks from the church. I have engaged in cottage meetings in previous pastoral appointments, but feel it will be particularly important at Riverside since you have not had a pastoral transition in twenty-five years.

During a cottage meeting, those present would have an opportunity to get to know me by asking questions. Likewise, I will also have an opportunity to hear what God has been doing in your midst and where the Holy Spirit may be leading in the future by

asking some questions of my own. At the end of any given evening, which should take between 60-90 minutes, we will all be a little more familiar with one another.

I want to stress that these listening posts will prove to be invaluable to me, so I hope that you will plan to attend one. Be sure to watch for opportunities to sign up to participate in a cottage meeting in the near future. If you wish to host a cottage meeting, please contact the church office. I look forward to getting to know you.

The schedule for our build will likely stay the same. The schedule for the second build will be full days Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday.
